This spring and early summer, The Wildlands Conservancy will offer a limited number of guided walks at the Pioneertown Mountains Preserve.

Devastated by the Sawtooth Complex fire in 2006, ***the preserve remains closed for fire restoration.*** However, on alternating weekends from March through June 2010*, visitors may join a guided hike to Chaparrosa Peak or a less strenuous walk into Pipes Canyon. The walks will focus on fire recovery and the natural history of the area.

Spectacular Views!

Approximately 7 miles
Moderate to strenuous

(1,000 ft. elevation gain and some rough trails)

Hike will take place rain or shine

Allow 3.5 to 4 hours for hike

Canyon Walk
View Cultural and Natural Resources!

Suitable for children and adults
Approximately 1.5 mile walk up canyon

(mostly level easy trails)

Does not include Olsen Ruins

Allow approximately 1 hour for hike
