Join an Oak Glen Preserve naturalist or special guest for a walk and talk on the Preserve trail.

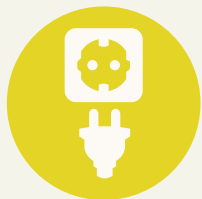
A different theme is presented each month. Ages 10 and older. Not suitable for pets. **Reservations Required.**
